**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing, 2021 – 2024 (RRS)*.
- 1.2. All boats shall be in compliance with their respective class rules.

**2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1. The regatta is open to Penguin class, Comet class and Albacore class boats.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website ([www.tayc.com/racing](http://www.tayc.com/racing)) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0900 on Saturday, May 1. Online registration is required. Bag lunch requests and payment (\$8 per lunch) must be received with registration.
- 2.3. Races may be cancelled for any class if less than three (3) boats have registered for such class by 1600 on Thursday, April 29.
- 2.4. All regatta participants, including skipper and crew, must individually sign and electronically submit the Covid-19 waiver found at [www.tayc.com/racing](http://www.tayc.com/racing) beforehand.

**3. FEES**

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$35 for CBYRA or US Sailing members, \$45 for non-members to be received no later than 0900 on Saturday, May 1.

**4. SCHEDULE**

- 4.1. 0830-0930 Free coffee, juice and bagels available at the Galley Window and bag lunches (\$8) may be purchased.
- 4.2. To ensure that social distancing is maintained, no Competitors' Meeting is scheduled.
- 4.3. 1100 Warning gun for first class
- 4.4. As many races as possible will be sailed, but no race will start after 1500.

**5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website no later than one week prior to race day and on race day in the clubhouse.

## **6. THE VENUE**

- 6.1. Races will be sailed in the Tred Avon River using drop marks, generally in the area between the TAYC clubhouse and Foxhole Creek. Location to be confirmed at Competitors' Meeting.

## **7. SCORING**

- 7.1. A boat's regatta score shall be the total of all her race scores unless six or more races have been completed, in which case her worst score will be excluded, subject to Rule 90.3(b).
- 7.2. At least one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

## **8. PRIZES**

- 8.1. Prizes will be given as follows: 1 if 3 finishers, 2 if 5 finishers, 3 if 7 or more finishers.
- 8.2. Prizes will be presented on the first floor of the TAYC clubhouse as soon as possible after the conclusion of racing.
- 8.3. Results will be posted at [www.tayc.com/racing](http://www.tayc.com/racing).

## **9. SPECIAL COVID-19 REGATTA RULES**

- 9.1. Social distancing as prescribed by the CDC shall be practiced at all times while on Club property.
- 9.2. Masks covering the nose and mouth shall be worn by all individuals while on Club property.
- 9.3. Current state requirements for protection against the transmission of Covid-19 must be practiced throughout the regatta.

## **10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
