Eligibility: This regatta is open to all one design fleets, including: Star, Penguin, Comet, Flying Dutchman, Chesapeake 20's, Club 420, Optimist Pram (all fleets).
Other One Design classes will be given a start by contacting Regatta Chairman, Si Boettner at 410.745.9492 no later than Monday 04 August 2010.
All registered boats must comply with their Class Association requirements.

Rendezvous: Skippers' Meeting on Saturday at 0915.
Specific fleet racing areas within the Miles River will be announced at the Skippers' Meeting.

Start: SATURDAY: At 1030 for all fleets; SUNDAY: At 1000 for Stars & Optis.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races) is changed as shown below.

Course: Event Sailing Instructions will be provided at registration. They may be posted at www.milesriveryc.org when available.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*"

Scoring: The Low Point Scoring system of Appendix A (RRS) will apply. One completed race constitutes a series. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores unless (4) four or more races are completed and then she may exclude her worst score

Awards: 1st/3, 2nd/5, 3rd/7+ starters. Stars will also be competing for the overall series *John Charles Thomas Memorial Trophy*. Awards ceremonies will be held Saturday and Sunday following each day's racing.

Social: *BREAKFAST:* Coffee and Donuts will be served Saturday and Sunday, included in registration fee. Regular Club Menu Breakfast service may be purchased on Sunday starting 0830 hours.
LUNCH: Buffet for \$ 7.00 for OPTI racers (Children 10 or under \$3) on Saturday and Sunday. On-the-water bag lunches may be purchased for \$7 (MUST BE ORDERED NO LATER THAN COB Saturday 31 July 2010; Call MRYC).
DINNER: Regular Club Menu Dinner service available 1730-2100 on Saturday 07 August 2010. Competitors should make their own reservations; all are encouraged to attend.
POOL: Pool passes are available for competitors in the Club office. Children 14 years of age and under must be supervised by an adult when in the pool area.

Other: *LAUNCHING AND BERTHING:* Beach, ramp, and lift launching are available. After unloading boats, vehicles and trailers should be parked in the Club field outside the main gate. Follow instructions of Launch Coordinator. Washing of boats must only be done in the MRYC field. Please note that due to Talbot County zoning restrictions, overnight camping on MRYC grounds is illegal and will not be allowed.
